


## Mark Swanson – Guitars and Vocal

Mark began playing professionally at 20 years old, and began playing with the Grand Rapids-based group **Horsefeather**. The band went on to record an album, and receive radio and television airplay as they played throughout the Midwest. In 1989, he began a solo musical career and played up and down the coasts of Michigan for the next ten years. During this period, Mark also took on the role of **Luthier**, a builder of stringed instruments. Mark builds all of the instruments he plays as well as instruments for many other musicians including the **Dixie Chicks** who used one of his mandolins on one of their albums which ultimately won five Grammy awards.


With the new millenium, Mark teamed up with singer/songwriter **Ken Bierschbach**. They played together until 2015, forming the band **13<sup>th</sup> Hour** in 2006. That group played until 2015 when Mark again struck out on his own, with the dream of forming the Trio now fulfilled.

He has performed with the **Early Blue Band**, **Country Roots Band**, **Straight Eight Times Three** featuring **Mike Kyle** and currently with the **Mark Swanson Trio**. ## **Bob DeCocq- Bass Guitar**

I started my musical journey as soon as I figured out how to turn on the radio. I first started performing in the mid 1970's in the West Michigan music scene with a band called the **County Line Band**. During this period I first met Mark, and the rest of **Horsefeather**. By the late 70's I had begun working with singer-songwriter **Marshell Baker**, which resulted in the recording of our L.P **"Baker, DeCocq and Friends"** in late 1981. This period was followed by a stint in Texas working with singer-songwriter **Shake Russell**. Upon returning to Michigan, Bob co-founded the **Just Jake Band** in 1990. Just Jake performed together for the next 20 years specializing in festivals, opening for national touring acts as well as various venues state wide. In early 2011 he began working with Kentucky singer-songwriter **David Hardin** and in 2012 signed with Nashville-based Ride Records, resulting in two CDs, **"Miles of nowhere"** and 2016's **"Magnolia"**. In 2018 he signed a songwriting and publishing deal with Phoenix-based Fervor Records. The highlight of 2019 was when two original songs were used in network television broadcasts on CBS and NBC. 2020 found Bob coming full circle to join his old friend Mark and new friend Kevin in the **Mark Swanson Trio**. Bob says, "in a nut shell, Music is what I do!"
